THOSE ELIGIBLE FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE NCAAA INCLUDE:

- Insurance policy with a \$1 million minimum
- At least one-third of the Operation is open to the public

BUILDER – \$500 -----

Builder Benefits:

- Voting privileges (1 vote per building company)
- Owners/employees are eligible to be elected to the Board
- Owners/employees can attend NCAAA meetings
- Receives newsletters/emails on our progress

Builder Requirements:

- ACCT PVM or equivalent
- Insurance policy with \$1 million minimum

PARTNER ORGANIZATION – \$250 -----

Partner Organization Benefits:

- Can attend NCAAA meetings
- Receives newsletters/emails on our progress

Partner Organization Requirements:

- Any interested group such as an insurance company or a camp/non-profit aerial adventure park (i.e. BSA, GSA, YMCA)

INDIVIDUAL – \$100 -----
